



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Sisters of Service Scholarship

The Sisters of Service Scholarship will be annually awarded to **two students (one youth and one adult)** who have expressed a desire to pursue further and/or continuing education.

Each recipient will be awarded a monetary reward of up to \$5,000.

The Applicant:

- Is a Child or youth up to 29 years of age or is an adult over the age of 29 years
- Resides, studies, or works within the geographic area of the Archdiocese of Toronto
- Is in good academic standing
- Is a recent immigrant or refugee to Canada who has obtained landed immigrant or permanent resident status over the past five years
- Must be endorsed by a teacher, an agency or community partner whose values align with those of CCAT.

Submission Documentation

Apply via email, including the following:

- A submission paper (2 pages) or short video (max 5 mins) outlining why you are pursuing a career in your field of study and the impact you hope to have on your community.
- Proof of acceptance into your program with an accredited institution.
- Two letters of references (e.g., academic, community involvement)
- Completed application to be submitted to Catholic Charities by April 30th to info@ccat.ca with the subject line: **Application for the Sisters of Service Scholarship**.
- These applications will be reviewed by the Scholarships and Awards Committee of the Catholic Charities Board of Directors to determine the qualified candidates for each scholarship between the months of June and July.
- The Committee will shortlist at least two qualified candidates for each scholarship and will schedule an interview with each candidate if needed.
- The Committee will make the final selection of the recipients for each scholarship and endorse the successful candidates to the CCAT Board by the third Thursday of September.
- Applicants will complete the attached declaration, attesting to the authenticity of their application. *Refer to Attachment 1 for the Attestat on*

Recognition

- The successful candidates will be informed by September 25th and will be expected to attend an awarding ceremony at a date determined by Catholic Charities, which will be recorded and posted on CCAT social media platforms and newsletter.
- The list of awardees and their contributions will be posted on CCAT social media platforms.
- A brief write-up on each awardee and service to the community will be published on the CCAT website and CCAT Newsletter.
